

**Sunset's Red Horizon** A classic tomato—with meaty, heart-shaped fruit as big as grapefruit and sweet, full-bodied flavor—this Russian native has good texture and plenty of rich juice. It made its American debut thanks to Gary Ibsen, founder of California's Carmel TomatoFest, who honored *Sunset* with its name.

**BBT Bacon Basil Tomato Sandwich** Split a piece (about 3½ by 5 in.) of **ciabatta bread** (or a crusty roll) in half lengthwise. Toast lightly. Spread cut sides generously with **mayonnaise**. Cover bottom half with 4 to 6 large **fresh basil leaves** and a thick layer of 4 to 6 slices **firm-ripe Sunset's Red Horizon** or similar large **tomatoes**. Sprinkle with **salt** and **fresh-ground pepper** to taste. Top with 2 slices **crisp-cooked bacon**. Cap with top half of ciabatta (or top half of roll). Makes 1 sandwich.
